RE: Frink America Project Activity
3rd Neighbor Letter

Dear Frink America Neighbor:

Today the on-site testing for ground contamination began with a crew from Lu Engineers along with assistance from members of the Municipal Force. The site was mowed with a brush-hog, only one flat tire, and tomorrow surface sampling will be underway. This activity is preformed with small hand tools and samples are collected in accordance WITH the "Work Plan" just recently approved by the NYS DEC. Other activities for testing, starting next week, will include much larger test holes and drilling to get core samples and add a few new test wells so ground water can be further tested. These activities will utilize heavy equipment and, again, will be in accordance with the "Work Plan".

In previous neighbor letters we informed you of inspecting and testing to locate asbestos in the buildings. This was completed, a design or plan to remove it was established and the work to remove it was put out to bid and was awarded to the low qualified contractor today. The contractor selected must be specifically licensed for "asbestos abatement". It will take about 30 days to check the contractor's credentials along with bonding and insurances, and finalize a contract. The actual on-site work is scheduled to start on or about 9/7/05.

The fence work done a couple of months ago can now be completed. We were waiting for the all-important "Work Plan" to be approved by the DEC. Now, two abandoned waterlines can be removed which will allow a small portion of the fencing to be completed. The DEC also informed us that that all the Frink America property must be fenced in as close to the property lines as possible and this is being reviewed and any adjustments are being made at this time.

Just a reminder, the entire Frink America property is considered a contaminated construction site until cleaned or proven otherwise. Only authorized personnel are allowed on the site by order of the New York State DEC and the Department of Health.
