The Town of Clayton is pleased to announce a recent award of \$700,000 to North County Affordable Housing, Inc. for their Mobile Home Replacement Program. All low-income resident owners of older mobile homes in the tri-County area, including Clayton, may receive a grant of up to \$35,000 toward the cost of replacing their mobile home with a stick-built home. Applications are available by calling 315-785-8684.

In addition, North County Affordable Housing, Inc. has several upcoming grant proposal submissions to their North County HOME Consortium and other sources for the following:

- Accessibility modifications for low-income households of disabled and elderly persons in Jefferson County;
- Owner-occupied housing rehabilitation including energy audits and energy upgrades for low-income households in Jefferson and Lewis Counties;
- Additional Mobile Home Replacement grants; and
- Grants for new home construction for low-income households in Jefferson, Lewis and St. Lawrence Counties.
